CONCURRENT RECEIPT. Did you know there are several bills in Congress once again addressing this issue? It's has been kicked around for nearly 20 years, but as it stands right now only disabled retirees with a rating of 50 percent or more can draw their full retired pay AND their full VA disability. Those under 50 percent have their VA disability pay deducted from their retired pay. I've been retired since June 1998 and this has cost my family over \$55,000. Please go to www.moaa. org. Tricare Co-pays for Retirees & Families Under 65 By Dave Melges



In the last newsletter I wrote about the increase in medication copays. This time I want you to know about other changes in your health care costs. Co-pays for retirees and families **under 65** using Tricare Prime with a civilian primary care doctor will now be \$20 and \$30 for specialist visits. If they use Tricare Select, the copays rise to \$28 for primary care, \$41 for a specialist visit and

25% of the charge if they see a Doctor out of the network.

Increases were also made to use of Ambulance \$40/\$98/25% (Prime/Select/out of network). Emergency Room \$60/\$109/25%. Hospital stay \$150/25% max \$250 daily +20% of additional services/25% max \$901 daily +25% of additional services.
